Safe and Drug Free Funds for the school district have been cut. Purchasing red ribbons will be difficult with the cut and Mrs. Harms suggested a brochure through the tobacco

funds. These funds can provide coloring books for the younger students and possibly a speaker for older students after school starts.

Mr. Hrstka suggested the DFD sponsor Red Ribbon Week. Mrs. Yost indicated the cost of ribbons run between \$500 to \$700 for the district. Mr. Hrstka complimented Mrs. Yost on past Red Ribbon Week activities. Superintendent Cline suggested purchasing the rolls of stickers at a lesser cost than the ribbons. Mrs. Yost asked if DFD would like to contribute money. On a motion by Principal Goodman and second by Lt. Aument, unanimous affirmative vote, the task force agreed to allow Mrs. Yost to check on prices for the stickers.

Mrs. Harms met with Hardee and Highlands who asked to partner with DeSoto during the Hardee/DeSoto game to sponsor a car show. The community is encouraged to decorate vehicles with anti-tobacco and parade them at some point during or before the game. The DFD members agreed this game is too congested, perhaps another game or different idea.
